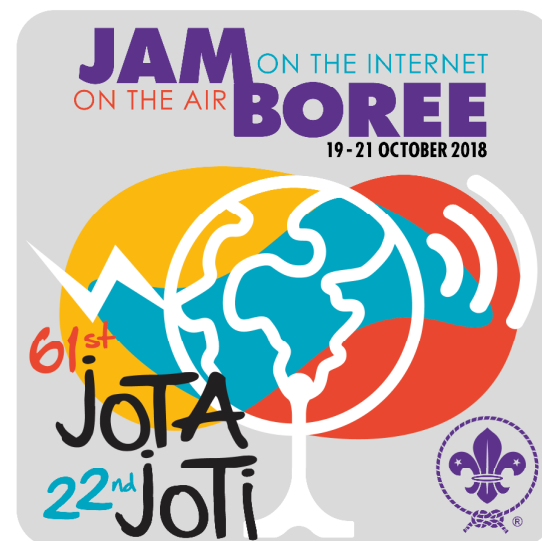

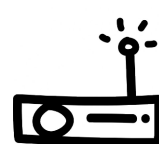

Did you know that before JOTA was fully launched a trial was held in October 1957, the location was in Reading, Berkshire (Yes, it really was that close!!). The trial was a success and the first "Boy Scout Jamboree-On-The-Air" took place on 10-11 May 1958. It is now held every year in the third full weekend of October. There are more than a MILLION participants worldwide every year, making it the largest annual event for Scouts.
