



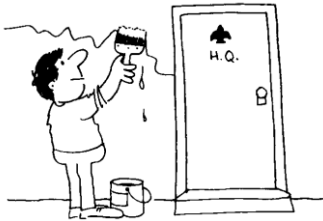

(Note: You don't have to be CRB'd to attend the BBQ)

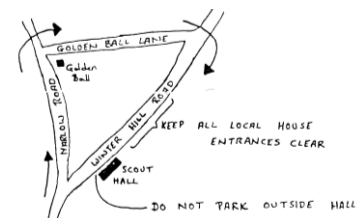

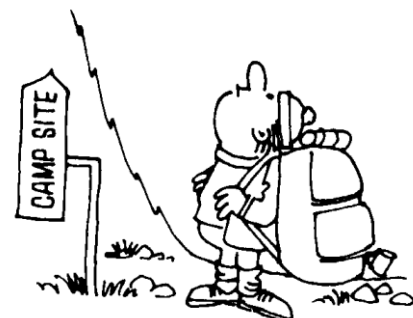
### Cross Country Competition
