

Obituary

Bill Hutt 1917 - 2013

Retired Assistant Scout Master and Group Executive Committee Chairman Bill (William) Hutt died on 13th January, aged 95.

Bill was born in 1917 and grew up at Lee Farm, Lee Lane in Pinkneys Green.

Bill was a Cub, Scout, and Rover Scout and when he became too old for Rovers he became an assistant scout leader, while helping with the Scouts he met Akela (Hilda) and they married in 1938.

Bill and Hilda had two sons Geoffrey and Michael, Michael is now a Trustee of the Group and supports probably best known as the ice man from Cookham!!.. They each had a son Mark and Ivan who were also cubs and Scouts at Pinkneys Green.

Bill has been associated with Pinkneys Green Scout group for 85years he continued to help fundraising at Jumble sales and Sum mer and Christmas Fairs for many years and it is only recently that he has not been that mobile, you may have seen him whizzing around in Cox Green on his mobility scooter in previous times. He and Hilda who died a few years ago also came with their extended family to the annual Whitsun family camps, this is where a group of parents camped with their families at various locations around the south of England in their own tents.

He attended the PG 100 year reunion which was held at the Stag and Hounds in 2009 and met several old friends who also attended. Bill was interviewed by the Maidenhead Advertiser in 1998, and said that although scouting was far more informal than in his years it still gave young people a good start in life teaching them scouting and social skills.
